School and Community

According to the 2010 census, North Smithfield is a suburban/rural town of 11,967 people living in Providence County, Rhode Island. North Smithfield is a residential town with limited commercial development that serves as a suburb of Providence, but with many residents also working in the Greater Boston Area.

The high school is a comprehensive building serving approximately 500 students in grades 9-12. The school is accredited by the New England Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges (NEASAC) and employs 42 faculty members, 3 counselors, 2 administrators, a school nurse, a part-time school psychologist, and a part-time school social worker.

Curriculum & Graduation Requirements for the Class of 2019

- ❖ Students in the class of 2018 must complete **25** credits to graduate including:
 - English (4), Mathematics (4), Science (3), Social Studies (3), Fine Arts (1), PE/Health (3), Senior Project (.5)
- ❖ Students must also successfully propose, complete, present, and defend a Senior Project of their choosing.
- ❖ Courses are designated either as Advanced Placement, Honors, College Prep, or Standard.

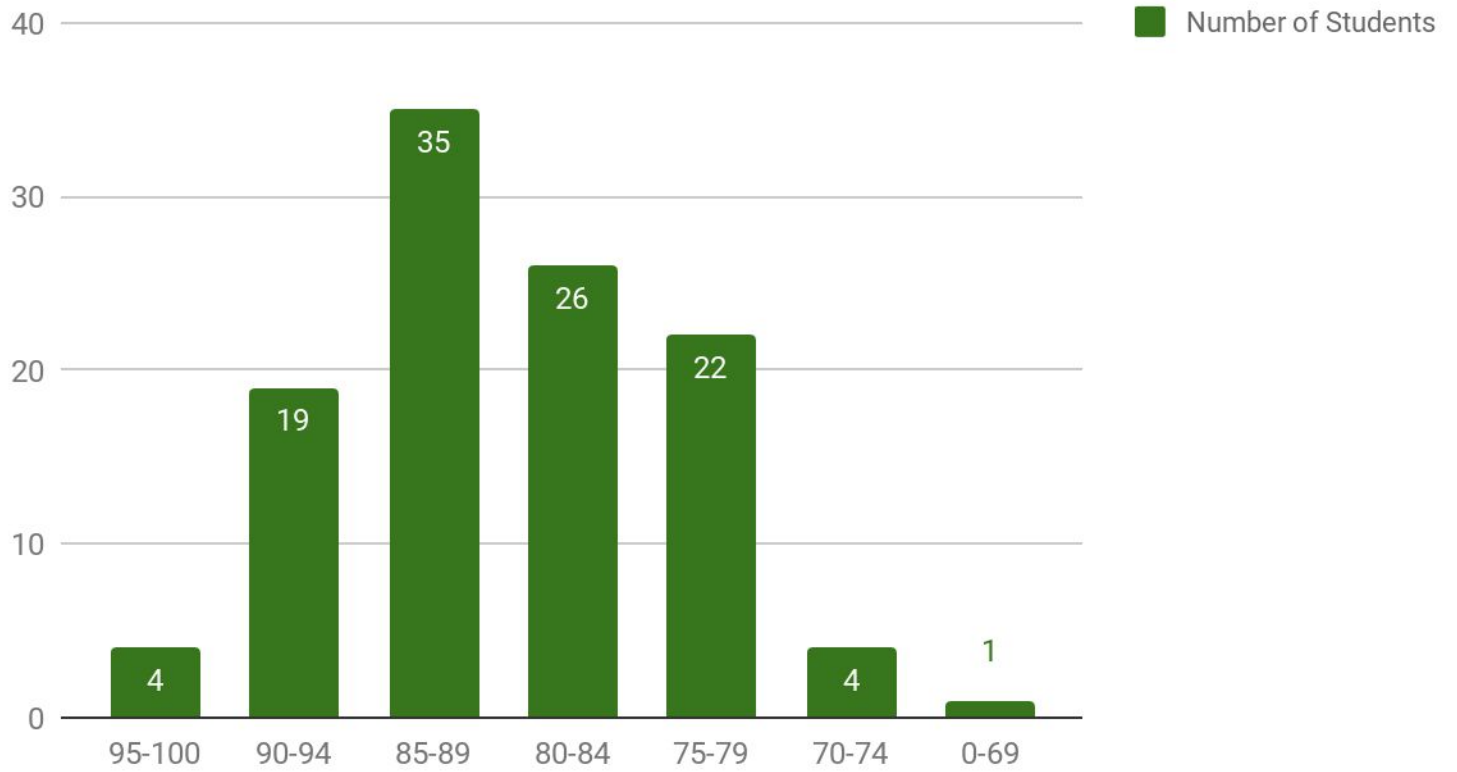

North Smithfield High School Grading System, Honors, and Class Rank

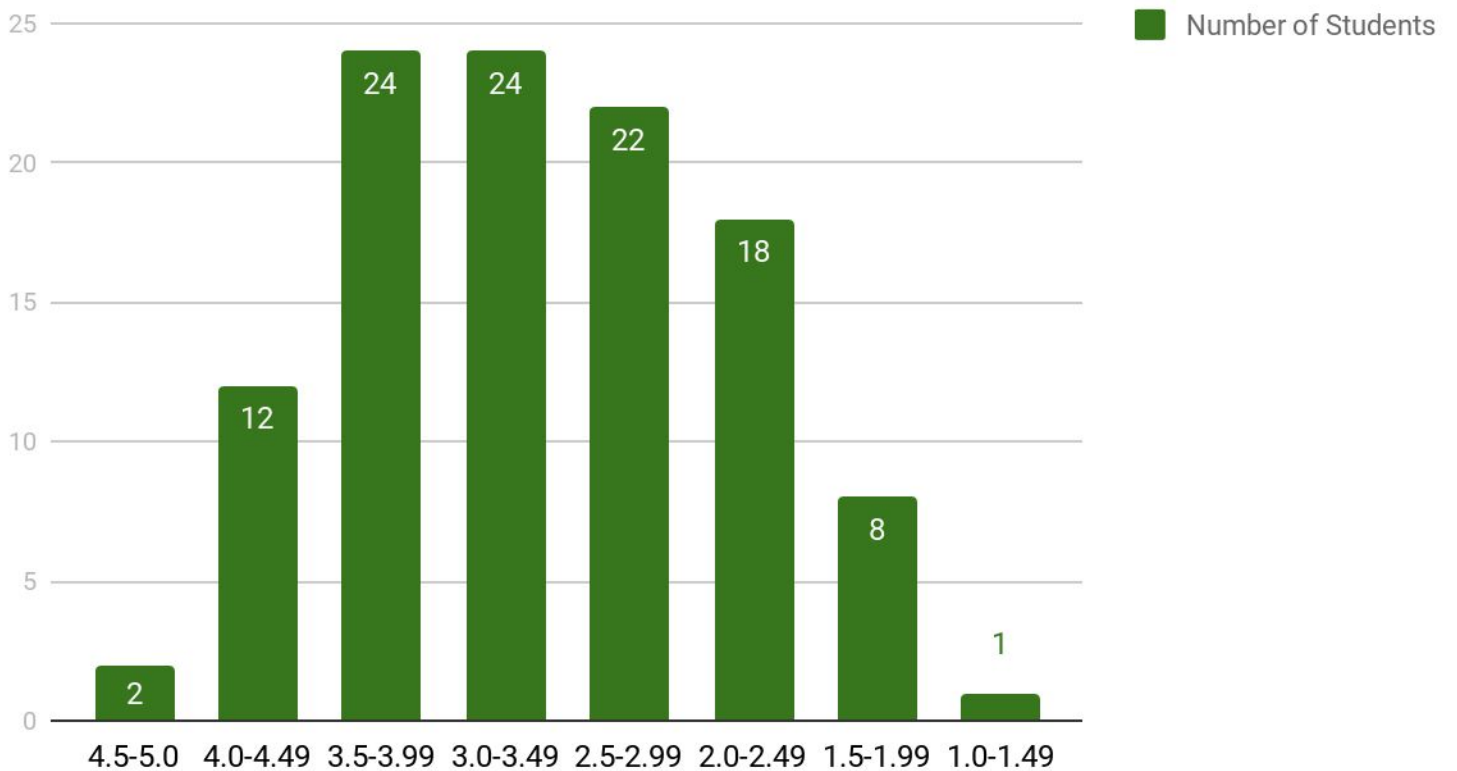
North Smithfield High School utilizes a weighted 4.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) system for class rank while also reporting traditional unweighted GPA. Special Education, Support classes, Senior Project & Physical Education/Health classes are excluded from these calculations. Final rank for seniors is computed at the end of their first semester of their senior year. This system places different weights on classes designated as AP, Honors, College Prep, and Standard. No credit is earned for grades below 70. Students earn credits at the semester beginning in the 2016-2017 school year.

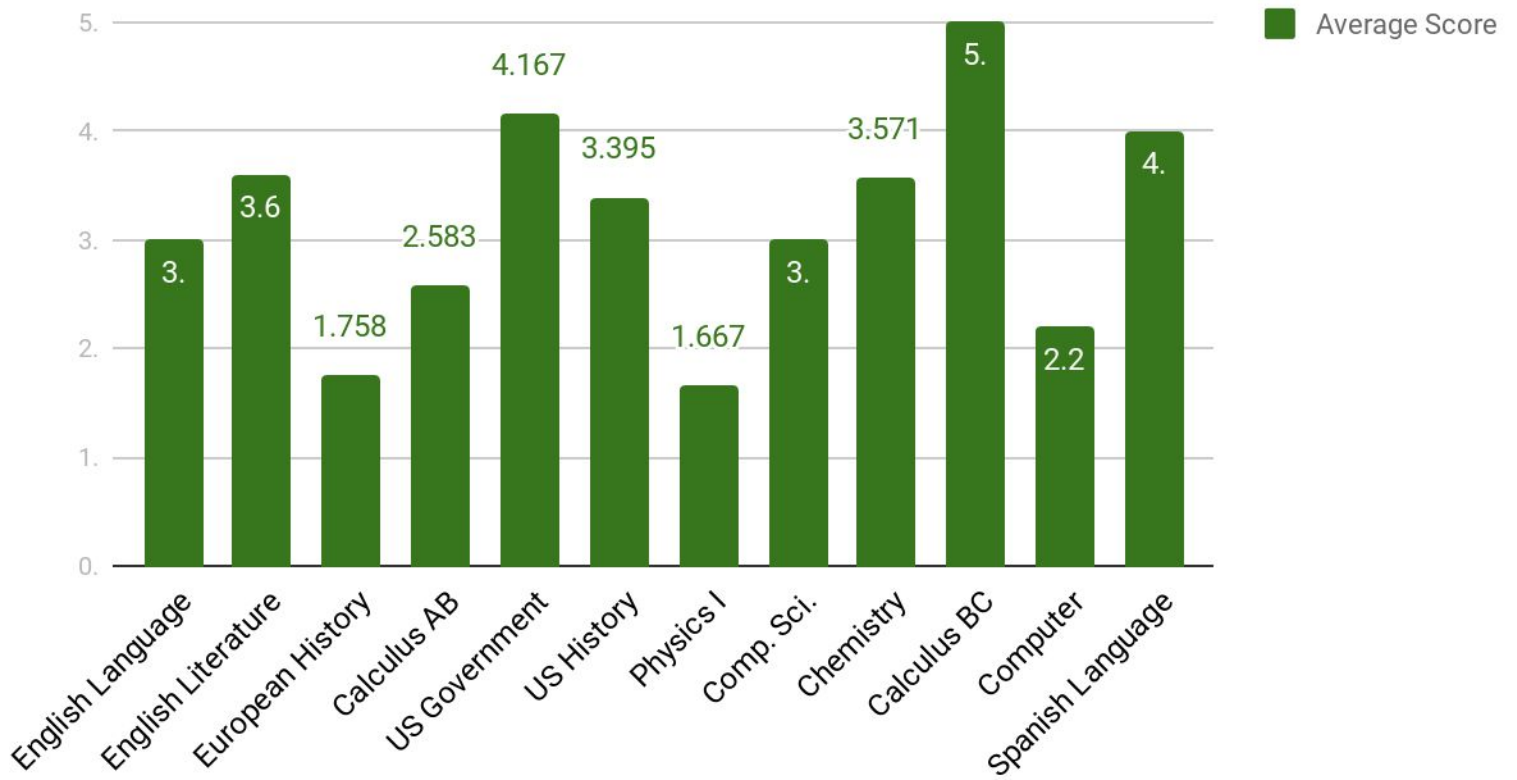
Unweighted GPA



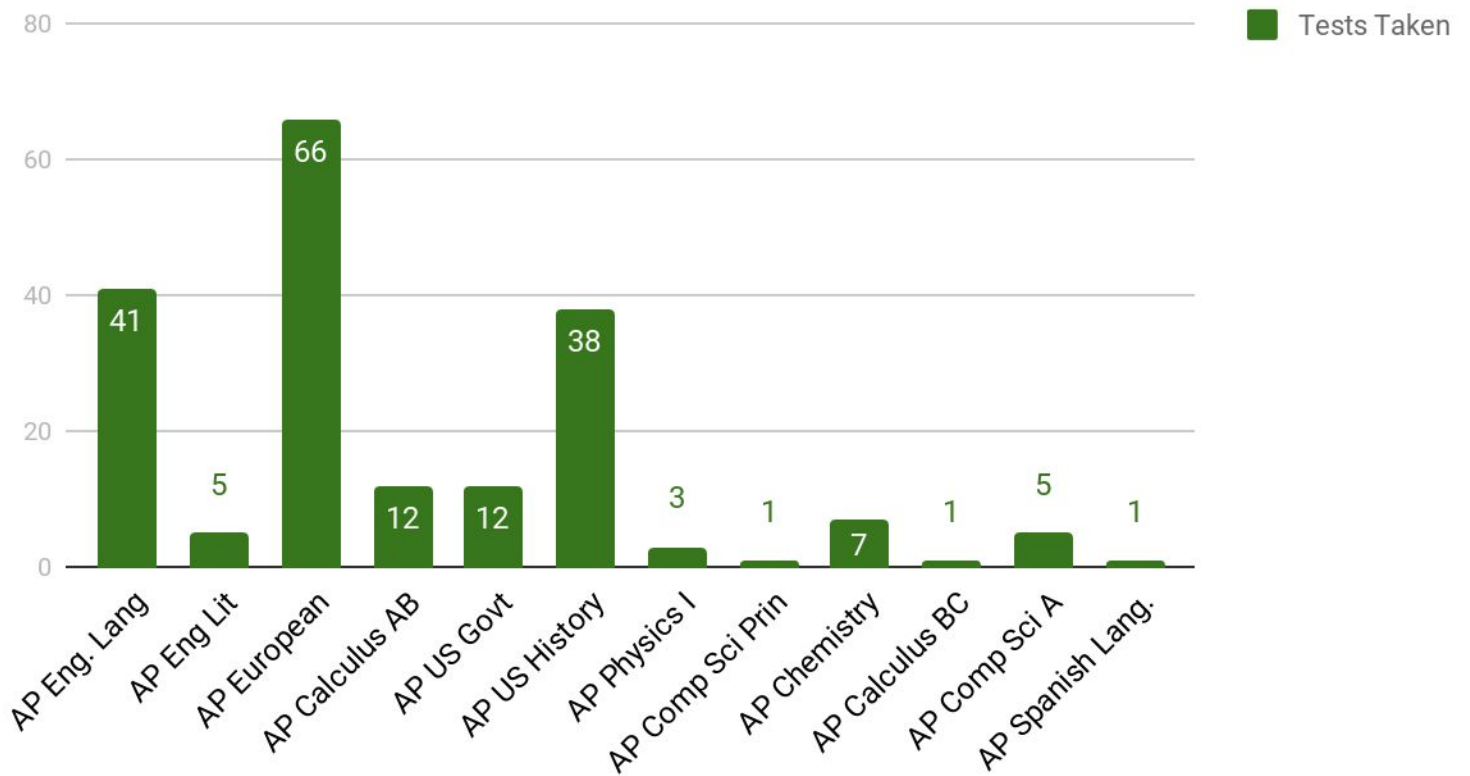
Weighted GPA



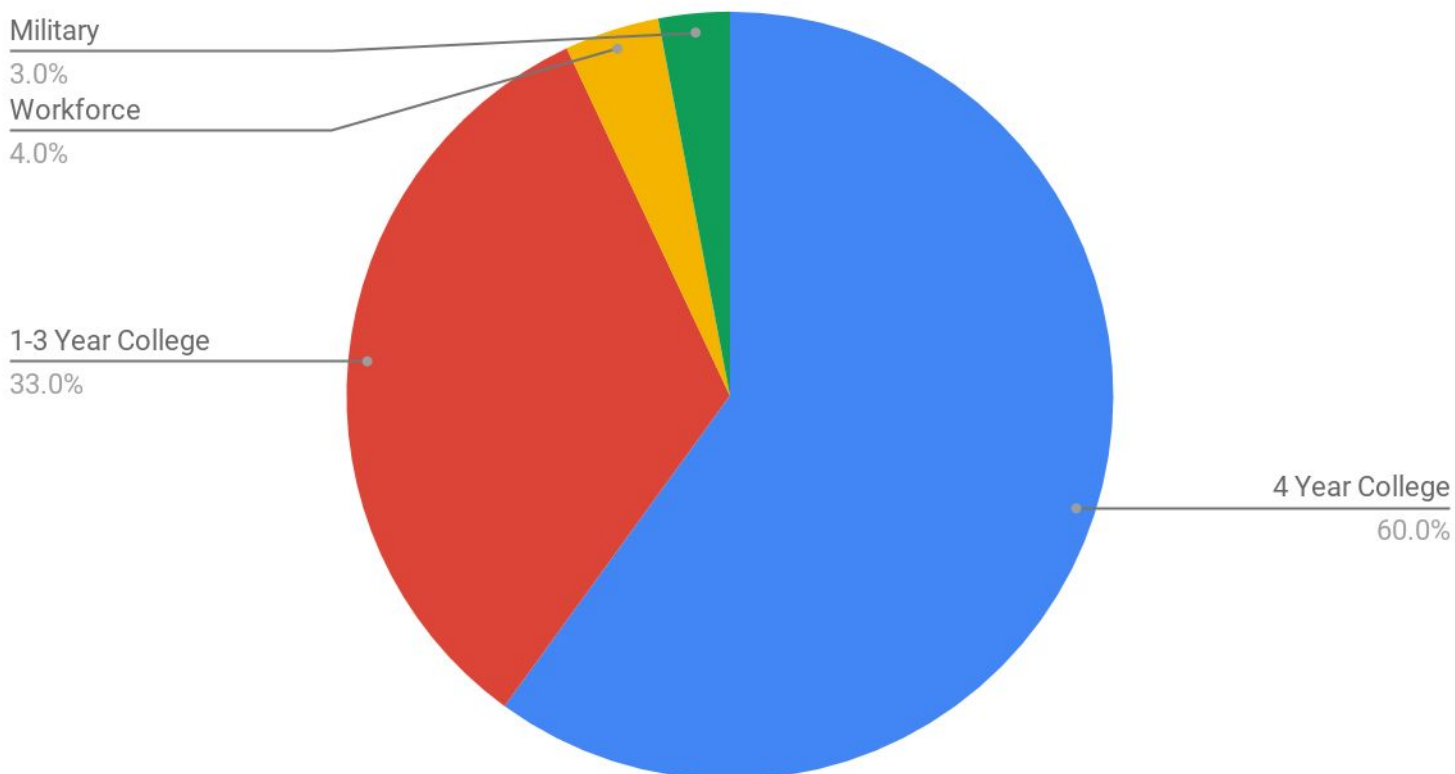
AP Results-2018
